In 1836, at the age of nine, Cynthia Ann was kidnapped by Indians and 24 years later recaptured by Captain Sul Ross of the Texas Rangers and returned to her white relatives. She was the mother of Quanah Parker who became the most powerful and famous Comanche chief of all. We are delighted to have Helen Garrison, who has been performing autobiographical portrayals since 1995, portray Cynthia Ann Parker. Ms. Garrison is a charter Heroes of History performer and a member of various storytelling organizations in Texas and Oklahoma.
